


It is a co-educational school with approximately 1500 students on its rolls studying from Classes Nursery to Class10.

Rules and Regulations

Admission:- A child to be admitted to Nursery should be of minimum three and a half years old. An interaction with the parents along with the child is required prior to the admission. No student will be admitted in a particular class if he/she is found overage for which admission is sought. Proper and appropriate age is one of the main criteria for admission of a candidate in any class.

Parents are asked to fill in the admission forms with the utmost accuracy. No subsequent changes will be



permitted thereafter for any reason whatsoever. Any student who has attended another school previously cannot be admitted without a Transfer certificate and conduct certificate.

Examination: -Promotions are given on the basis of one year's work and not merely on marks scored in the final exams. Every student must be present for the terminal exams. The result declared at the end of the year is final and cannot be reconsidered and in any questions of promotion or failure. Decision of the Principal is final.

Withdrawal: -Before withdrawing a student from the school a month's notice is to be given or a month's fee in lieu of notice. The Principal reserves to herself the right to dismiss the students, who fail to make satisfactory progress in his/her studies or whose conduct in any way is detrimental to discipline of the institution, for immorality, insubordination or contempt without prior notice to the parents.

school Fees:- The school fees covers twelve Calendar months and may be paid in monthly, instalments or in advance. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods. Students are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls. Fees once paid will not be refunded. Fees are payable in the bank till 13th of every month as well as online through hfscampuscare.in, in due time failing which late fee will be levied from the following month. The school reserves right to revise the fees without prior notice.

General Guidelines for Parents and Students: Parents are always welcome to interview the Principal to discuss the progress of the children during the meeting hours or through prior appointment. Parents/Guardians have no entry to the class rooms. Students must be in the school well in time.

Any student who has been absent for more than 10 calendar days without the Principal's permission or without proper information to the school will be struck off the roll and may not be re-admitted. In case of genuine and convincing reasons for the absence the Principal may grant permission to students to continue, provided he/she take re-admission in the school paying fresh admission fee and clearing all pending dues to the school.
