- **Supportive Environment:** "Doubt-Busting Clinics" provide an open-floor format where students are encouraged to ask deep conceptual questions to ensure total clarity.

On April 14th, Fr. Sony John CMF, Principal of St. Claret School, Barrackpore, helmed an enlightening seminar tailored for the parents of Class 9 and 10 students. The session offered a comprehensive comparative analysis of the CBSE and ICSE curricula, alongside a warm orientation for parents of class 10 students, embarking on their journey with our school community.

Fr Sony John emphasized that ISC is the best, the underlying philosophy is that schooling shouldn't just be a coaching center for a single entrance exam. ISC aims to build an articulate, globally competent individual who possesses the soft skills, writing capabilities, and analytical mindset needed to excel in college and the modern workforce.

## TEACHERS' ORIENTATION SEMINAR

On the same day following a brief intermission, Fr. John spearheaded a dynamic professional development workshop tailored specifically for the teaching faculty, designed to equip them with modern pedagogical tools to navigate contemporary classroom challenges. To maintain high engagement, the session was interspersed with insightful short videos, making the entire experience both visually stimulating and profoundly impactful.

He passionately advocated for a paradigm shift in classroom dynamics, suggesting that students should be given meaningful opportunities to take the lead and try their hand at teaching. By stepping into the educator's shoes, students not only build confidence but also develop a deeper ownership of their learning journey. Parallely, Fr. John highlighted that true classroom harmony begins with empathy. He reminded teachers that academic instruction must be balanced with compassionate listening, urging faculty members to create safe spaces where students feel heard and can comfortably voice their personal or academic problems.

Recognizing that the demands of modern teaching can take a heavy toll on educator well-being, the session also prioritized mental health. Notably, Fr. John advocated for the integration of therapeutic laughter exercises as a potent antidote to daily stressors. He demonstrated how intentional, physiological laughter can instantaneously lower cortisol levels, release endorphins, and break the tension inherent in a high-stakes academic day.

By blending innovative multimedia, practical pedagogy, and wellness techniques, Fr. John reminded the faculty that a teacher's greatest asset is a resilient, empathetic mind—proving that the best tools for serious classroom management are often rooted in open listening and shared joy.

### The Tribal Pulse (The Heartbeat)

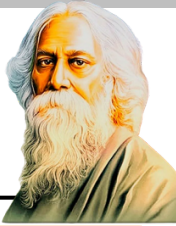

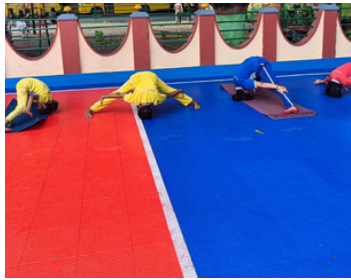
